Council members are appointed by Cabinet and will be led by a Chair who represents the Government of Alberta.

The Regional Advisory Council will also provide advice based on input received through regional public, stakeholder and Aboriginal consultation, and background information provided by the Government of Alberta.

Successful candidates for the Regional Advisory Council will be notified directly. Expenses and honorariums will be provided to council members. Closing date for nominations is April 23, 2014.
