- Enhance efficient land use in areas where petroleum and petrochemical investments are expected to
 occur
- Enhance collaboration between Government of Alberta, municipalities, landowners and industry in the implementation of the efficient use of land principles
- Increase the current level of involvement and partnership by and between various groups (e.g., nonprofits, private sector, aboriginal and local governments) and the Government of Alberta, in the area of land-use planning
- Strengthen regional infrastructure, community planning, and development in order to support economic expansion and population growth
- Facilitate efficient transportation of products to local, national and international markets
- Maintain a viable agricultural land base to support growth and diversification of the agricultural industry
- Attract tourism investors and developers (specific to Crown land) through longer-term tenure
